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Academic achievements 2021-2022

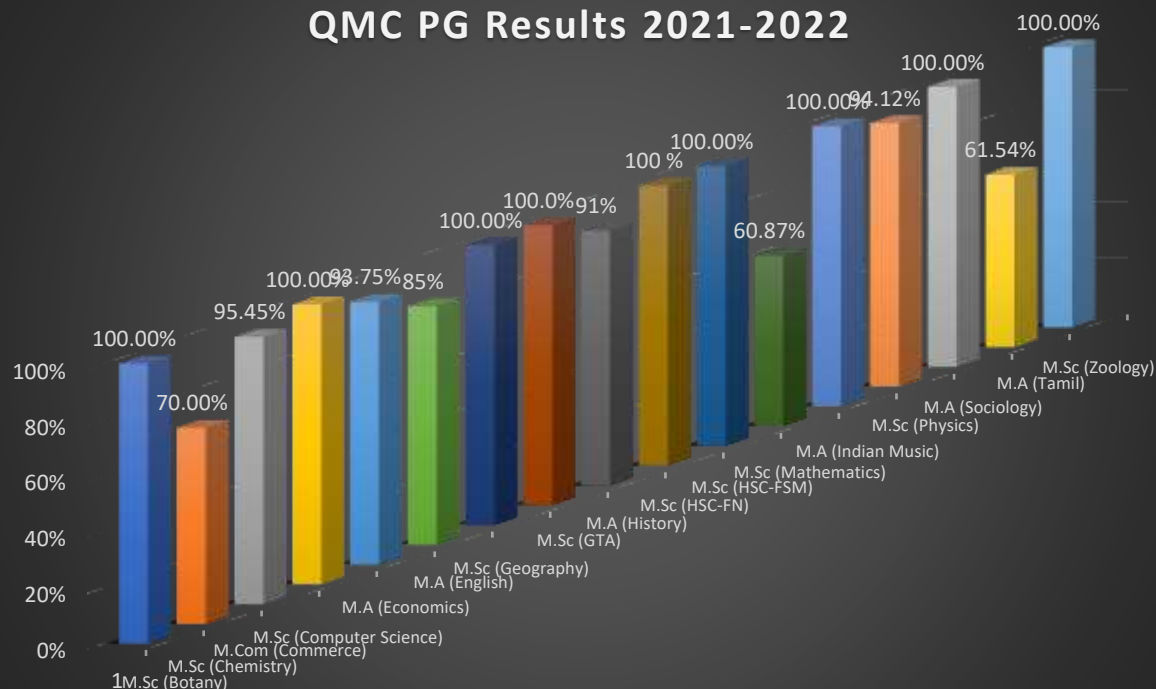

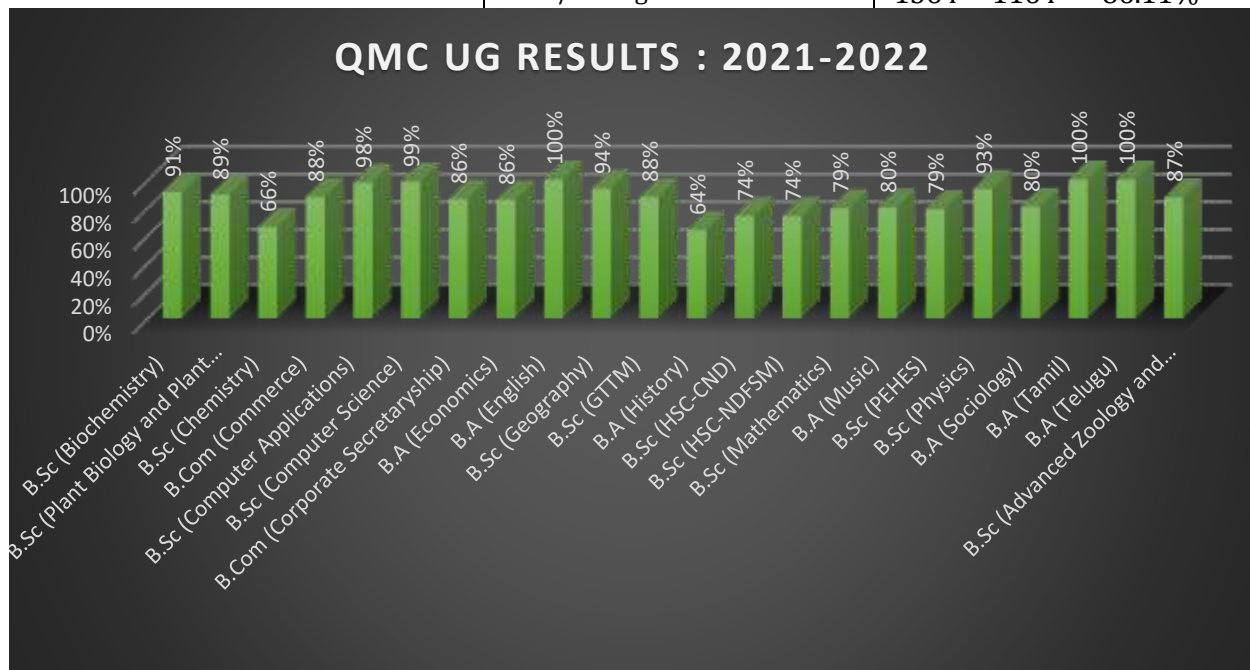

The Post graduate Department of Home Science and Nutrition Society of India (NSI) Chennai Chapter jointly organized a National Webinar on **Sustainable Food Systems for Nutrition and Health** in connection with Nutrition Month Celebrations on 23rd September 2021 at 11.30 a.m.

The webinar was relayed on Google platform with live streaming of the event through the NSI You tube Channel. Dr. C. Kalaivani Ashok, Head of the Home Science Department, Queen Mary's College, welcomed the gathering. Dr. B. Uma Maheswari, Principal, QMC, delivered the Presidential address, wherein she stressed the need for protecting and promoting breast feeding. In the first technical session, Dr. Sidharth Waghalkur, Deputy Head of Nutrition and School Feeding programme in UN World Food Programme, spoke on Decentralized Models for Take Home Rations under the ICDS scheme. In the next session, Dr. Hariharan, Senior Scientist, M.S. Swaminathan Research Foundation, highlighted the need for the use of Nutrigardens, which ensured availability and accessibility of micronutrients to the community and was considered to be an effective way of implementing availability of sustainable food systems.

In the final session, Dr. MallikaBadrinath, culinary expert, in her narrative on Millet Recipes-listed a volley of recipes and methods for preparing nutritious recipes using a variety of millets.

The Inauguration of Literary Association

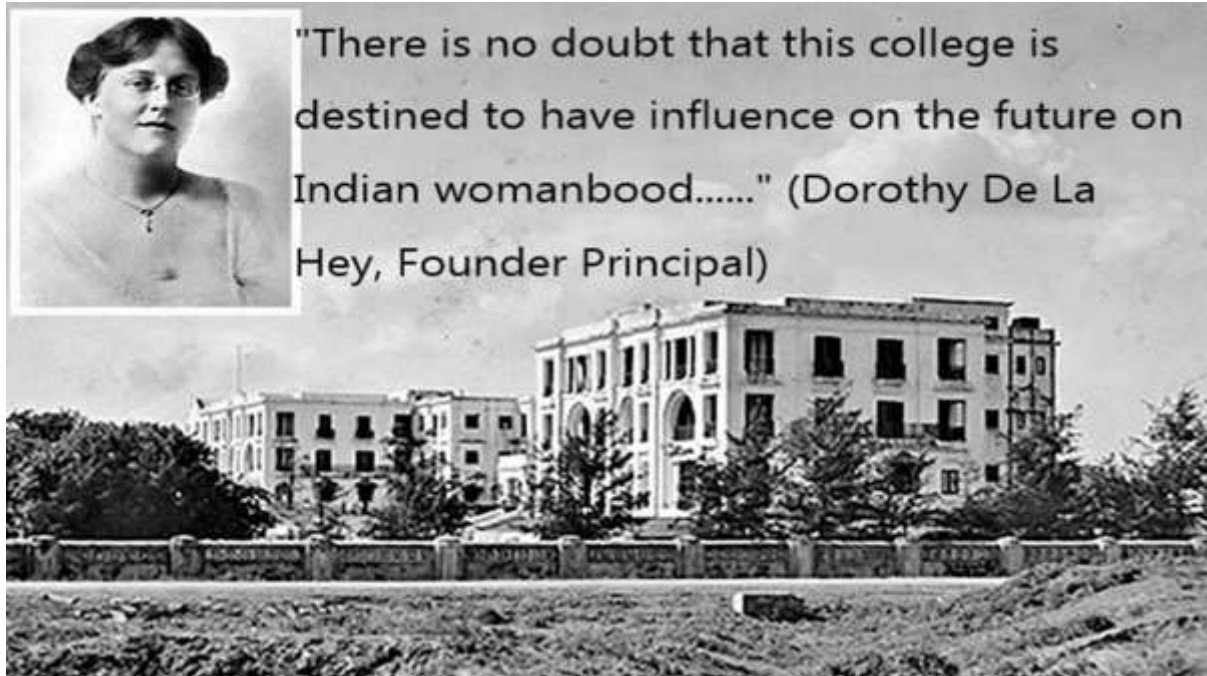

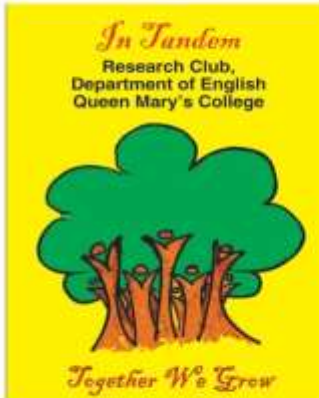

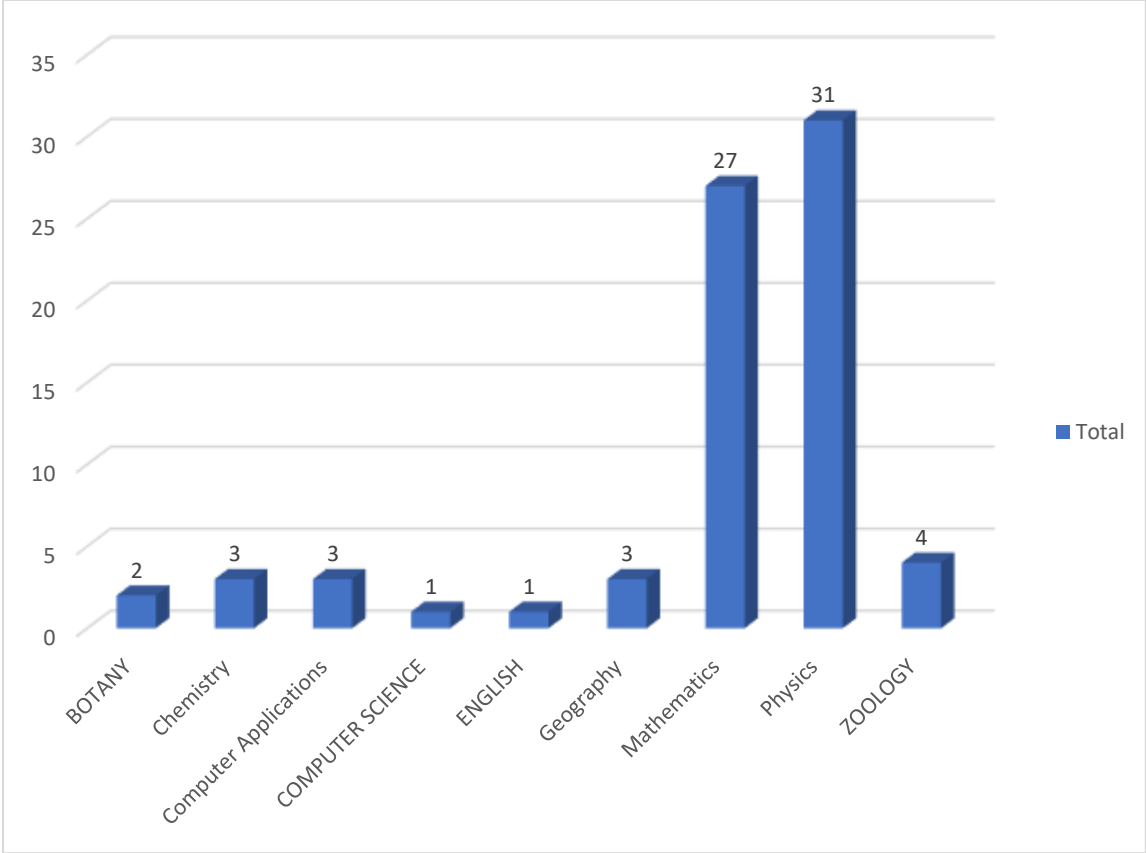

IQAC REPORT 2021-2022

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college has embraced the vision of NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council), in endeavoring “To make quality the defining element of higher education...through a combination of self and external quality evaluation, promotion and sustenance initiatives.”

The IQAC team for the college for the period 2021 to 2022 comprises Dr. Maria Preethi Srinivasan, (Administrative Coordinator, IQAC), Associate Professor, Department of English, Dr. J. Srividya, (Technical Coordinator, IQAC), Associate Professor, Department of Physics, Dr. S. Vanaja, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Applications, (Member, IQAC), Dr. S. Sarojini, Assistant Professor, Department of Physics, (Member, IQAC), and Mrs. G. Priyadharshini, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science, (Member, IQAC). Many meetings (9) were structured to improve the quality of educators and being educated students.

1. After the pandemic, the IQAC of the college geared up to equip all the support system to faculty members to get a global reach. On July 21st 2022, Russian Language Courses at Russian House, Chennai, together with Queen Mary's College, Chennai, held the Faculty Development Programme in Basic Russian. The Faculty Development Programme in Basic Russian was held for the tutors of II BA/BSc Classes and other faculty of Queen Mary's College. More than 75 faculty joined this programme including Dr. Maria Preethi Srinivasan Associate Professor and Head Department of English, Dr. Uma Maheswari Assistant Professor and Head Department of Sanskrit, Dr. M. Vijaya Associate Professor and Head Department of Mathematics, Dr. K. Sathyabama Associate Professor and Head Department of Sociology, Dr. E. Malathi Associate Professor and Head Department of Zoology, Dr. E. Uma Associate Professor and Head Department of Physical Education & Sports, Assistant Professors, Guest lecturers from various departments. The Programme was inaugurated by the Principal of Queen Mary's College Dr. B.Uma Maheshwari with words about the importance of learning new languages in the modern world and the opportunities it provides. Ms.Evgeniya and Ms.Valentina made a presentation about the benefits of learning Russian Language, taught the participants basic Russian phrases, alphabet and basic conversations.

2. The evaluation of Program Outcome-Course Outcomes(PO-CO) and Program Specific Outcomes Program Outcome(PSO-PO) mapping were familiarized to the faculty and the faculty were given hands on training to familiarize with Bloom's taxonomy in setting and assessing the K levels of question papers. Nearly 3 meetings were organized for the workshop.

3. The IQAC in 2021-22 continues carry out annually the healthy practices outlined by NAAC, getting the feedback from Parents, Students and Alumni, being one of them. These three groups of stakeholders were contacted for feedback even this year and Online Feedback forms have been collected and SWOC has been carried out to identify our strengths and weaknesses. Strategic Plan has been evolved to enhance our strength to overcome our weaknesses and to face challenges.
4. Proposal to introduce Certificate Courses to the students on core and non-core areas were submitted to the Government authorities.
5. Various Committees have been steered to work towards achieving quality standards in education and employability of students.
6. College Website was renovated and revitalized as an interactive platform catering to the demands of the presentday requirements. Data Management has been critically planned with effective documentation.
7. Series of meetings and workshops were conducted on a weekly basis, creating awareness about registering oneself in Publons/ Google Scholar/Web of Sciences and update their research profile. Nearly 191 faculty got registered finally and IQAC was instrumental in the Campaign.
The IQAC, a vital organ of the entire system at Queen Mary's College, will continue to work in sync with all the major parts of the system to ensure that the college is a vibrant force in shaping the lives of young women through higher education.

PARENT TEACHER'S ASSOCIATION (PTA)

QMC's PARENT TEACHER'S ASSOCIATION plays a significant role in building effective co-operation and partnership between home and college. Meetings were held to facilitate effective online and offline interaction with parents in the college hours. Periodical Meetings with the parents were carried

out on Saturdays with parents and feedback through google forms were collected from them.

CAREER GUIDANCE CELL (GCC)

The Annual Report for the Year 2021 – 22

The career cell for the students has been strengthened with appropriate guidance to choose the right career path based on their knowledge and skills. The cell also provides need based competitive exams. Prominent career counsellors within and outside the college are invited in frequent manner and arrange meaningful interaction of students with them.

The cell helps each student in exploring placement opportunities by inviting various companies for campus recruitment of students who are in the final year of UG and PG and are likely to graduate at the end of the academic year.

Keeping in view the competence, interests and acquired knowledge of the students, the cell conducts various programmes/sessions during the academic year 2021 -22.

- 20.12.2021 - The Employment exchange department and Backward, Most Backward classes and minorities welfare department of Tamil Nadu government jointly organized awareness programme for the minorities students to get success in their career. This programme was held in Queen Mary's College. Around 500 students from various colleges took part in this event.
- 01.03.2022 - The coordinators of the career guidance cell and placement cell of Queen Mary's College organized for the students of our college, the Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu programme on 01.03.2022. Around 200 students were watching this programme in state television through online mode. Chief minister Thiru. M.K. Stalin launched an ambitious skill development scheme for students in state, with the

initiative aimed at honing the educational skills, knowledge, talent and efficiency of 10lakh youth annually – Titled “Naan Muthalvan” (I am first).



The scheme envisaged tapping the special talents of students in government and aided schools, Colleges and Universities and further encourage them, which include guiding them on their further education path also. Students will be imparted coding and robotics classes in tune with modern times while experts will advise them an aspect, including physical health and behaviour related one, it said.

All of these experts created educational awareness for students and also motivated the youth by saying one person's intelligence cannot be assessed based on entrance examination. They asked them to choose their options based on the interest and aptitude to achieve their goal. Also motivated youth to invent new things, created awareness about data science where the employability is more, quoted examples of youth winners in their goals, etc.

In our college, the Keynote address was delivered by Dr. (Tmt.) S. TAMILSELVI, Associate Professor and HOD, Department of Tamil and Dr. (Tmt.) M. RAZIA PARVIN, Associate Professor and HOD, Department of History. Both of them created awareness and motivated the students of our college, since we are lacking in skills and employability. And also said till you get success you should work for it

- 15.03.2021 – Orientation programme on TNPSC group examinations was given by Thiru. Baskaran Krishnamurthy (UPSC and TNPSC Trainer and Retd., Senior Income Tax Officer) and Thiru. A. Abdul Kareem, Clerical Assistant, Queen Mary's College motivated the students to apply TNPSC examinations. He has given online demonstration for the students to apply for TNPSC group 2 and group 4 examinations.

TNPSC training programme has been started from 01.04.2022 - 27.04.2022 for group 2 and group 4 applicants both in offline and online mode. Around 500 students were participated in this training programme, where 80 students applied for group 2 and 200 students applied for group 4 respectively. The training was given by Thiru. Umachandar (UPSC and TNPSC trainer) and teaching faculties from various departments such as Tamil, English, Economics, Physics, Botany and Zoology of our college.



- 24.03.2022 - Valliappa Foundation – Tec Mahindra conducted the orientation programme for medical coding, medical billing and AR calling in the Home Science, Biochemistry, Botany and Zoology departments separately. They are interested to give placement support for the 3 months training completed students. Yet to be initiated the process for training programme.



- 01.04.2022 - MOU was signed by Mr V Mugunthan, Director of Accountants Learning Hub on August 2022 for the free off campus and offline training programme for 1 to 1^{1/2} months. The training was conducted for the recommended and willing UG final year students from Commerce, BCA and Computer Science. Totally 81 students have trained from Queen Mary's College, among which 44 students for accounts and 37 Students for EDI online filing. 10 Students were placed for commerce and 10 students in EDI online filing. After course completion all of them received certificates.



- 25.05.2022 - The Chief Minister M.K. Stalin has been inaugurating the “Illaignar Thiran Thiruvizha” at Queen Mary's College. He called upon the youth to make use of the event organised by the Departments of Rural Development and Labour Welfare and Skill Development in coordination with government agencies.

Minister for Rural Development K R Periakaruppan, Minister of Labour Welfare and Skill Development C V Ganesan, Greater Chennai Corporation Mayor R Priya, elected representatives and senior officials were present.

Mr. Stalin said, “We should train our youth to become skilled and talented. We should create a youth force. For that, we need to give them education – not basic but advanced. We must give the educated youth employment based on their qualification. They need to get an appropriate pay. By giving them a complete life, they will work for this country by realising the complete potential”.

In this programme around 30 companies were created stalls and 500 students from Queen Mary’s College interestingly visited the stalls in various sectors. They learned about the employment potential of various sectors and options of training available to them to improve their skills.

- 06.06.2022 – “Career Awareness Programme in Petrochemical Technology” was conducted by Mr. A.G.S. Neelakandan, Co - Ordinator UG/PG, Head Placement, Central Institution of Petrochemical Engineering Technology (CIPET): IPT, Chennai. Around 300 students from various science departments took part in this orientation programme. He has motivated the students to join in various post graduate diploma and PG courses. At the end of completion of courses 100% placement support will be given by CIPET.
