On Day 3 21.08.2021 Ms. Divya II year BA Sanskrit student sang a Sanskrit song.

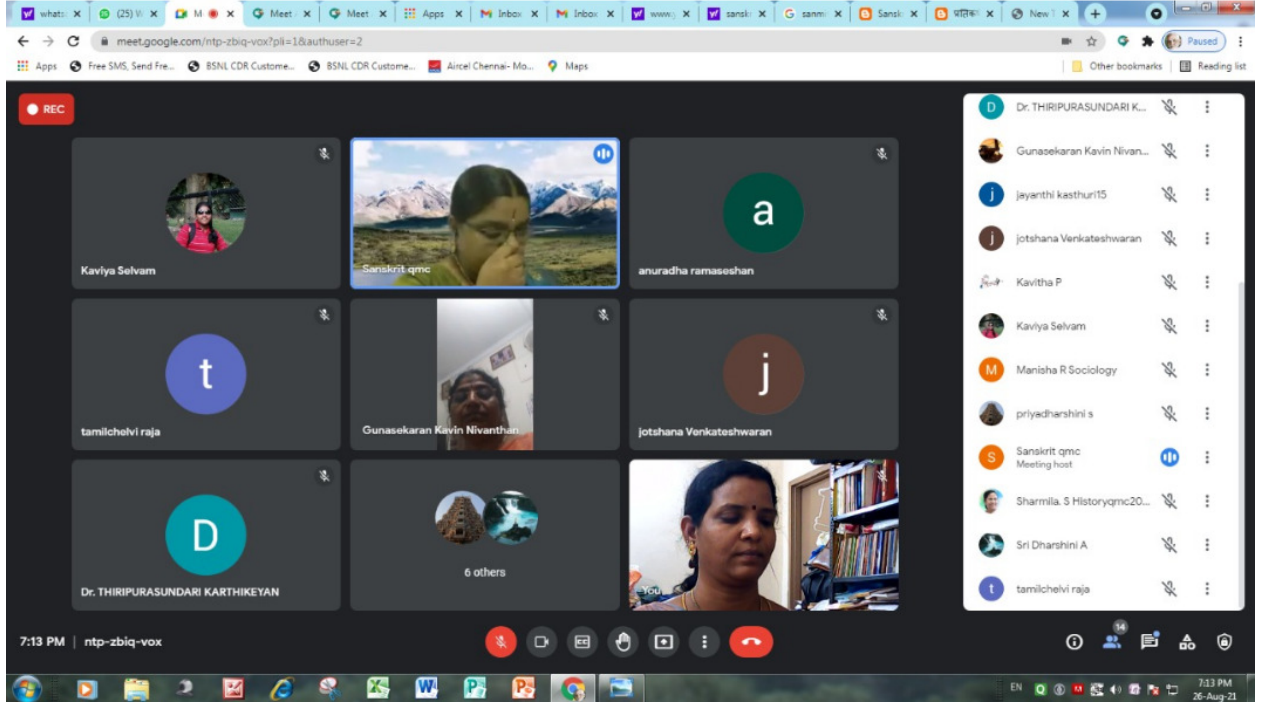
