Literospectrum 2025 had a flying start with the Inauguration on 21st January 2025. The event was themed Celebration of Linguistic Diversity at QMC. The Inauguration with its' unique theme was fraught with synergy on account of the coming together of all the "language departments' to convey to the young Queen Marians of the Department of English, the great heritage of the college with respect to linguistic diversity. The heads of the Departments of French, Tamil, Telugu, Sanskrit, Hindi and Urdu rendered the beautiful sounds of their respective languages through poems and songs and introduced the audience to functional and literary expressions in the languages each of them showcased. Dr. Varalakshmi presented a poem in French on the transient beauty of a rose and a musical rendition of the poem. Dr. Sivasakthi, emphasized the greatness of Tamil and how language encompasses verbal, nonverbal and graphic means of communication. Dr. Uma wooed the audience to appreciate Sanskrit through a 'boat song' in Sanskrit. Her presentation was participatory - the students enjoyed singing and simulating rowing. Dr. Mohanakumari presented beautiful lines from Telugu Literature which emphasize noble behavior. Dr. Vijayalakshmi acquainted the audience with numbers in Hindi.
