A Fabric Painting Workshop was conducted on August 22, 2023, by the highly skilled and expert Fevicryl teacher, Mrs. Shyamla Devi. This workshop was organized for students from II B.Sc Nutrition Food Service Management and Dietetics in the Department of Home Science, Queen Mary's College, Chennai.

Mrs. Shyamla Devi gave a brief introduction to fabric painting, its history, and its significance in clothing design. The workshop included hands-on sessions where students learned about different fabric painting techniques, such as block printing, brushwork, filling, blending, positive negative paintings, inner to outer and outer to inner strokes and stencil designs. She listed the criteria to be followed in selecting the right materials and paints. Mrs. Shyamla Devi demonstrated several fabric painting techniques on a variety of fabrics, giving students a clear understanding of the processes involved. Students actively engaged in the workshop, practicing the techniques they learned under the expert guidance of Mrs. Shyamla Devi. They had the opportunity to paint on sample fabrics provided. Mrs. Shyamla Devi encouraged students to ask questions and provided insightful answers to help them grasp the concepts and overcome any challenges they encountered. At the end of the workshop, students had the chance to showcase their creations, and Mrs. Shyamla Devi provided feedback and suggestions for improvement. Dr. S.Vijayapriya, Faculty member assisted the students with their work. Students gained a clear understanding of fabric painting techniques and their potential applications. The feedback from students was overwhelmingly positive, and they expressed a sense of accomplishment, having created their own fabric art pieces during the workshop.
