## **Minutes of the Academic Council meeting**

- The principal Dr. B. Uma Maheswari delivered the welcome address.
- The Controller of Examinations highlighted the following:
  - Reforms of UG Curriculum as per TANSCHÉ.
  - Adoption of Recommendations made in the Previous Academic Council Meeting.
  - Board of Studies Meeting 2023 – 2024.
  - Examination Reforms kept for approval.
- The following courses are introduced for all UG programmes with common syllabus.  
Value Education, EVS and Professional Competency
- The Heads of the Departments highlighted as the resolution made by the Board of Studies (BOS) committee for the UG Syllabus to be followed as from the academic year 2023 – 2024.

## **BOS Minutes of the Departments**

### **Department of Physics:**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024

- Practicals in each semester **related** to the theory learnt has been introduced.
- Generic elective- allied physics theory is offered in one semester and practicals in the succeeding semester for ibsc mathematics and ii bsc chemistry. Ancillary physics – i and ii form the other options.
- Microsoft excel, digital photography, printed circuit board design, home electrical installation form the skill enhancement courses in the first 4 semesters of part iv. These papers will have theory exam as a google quiz for 25 marks and practical for 50 marks in the end semester examination. Group activity, test, assignment will be the cia pattern.
- Two courses on problem solving skills have been introduced as skill enhancement courses in two semesters, this covers all the physics concepts, and will develop analytical skill.
- A new paper on introduction to **all topics** in physics forms the basis of the foundation course to bridge the gap in school learning.
- General mechanics, classical mechanics and mathematical methods have been combined into a single paper to pave way for new courses.
- It is proposed to conduct a minimum of 10 experiments in each semester.
- Professional components like expert lectures, seminars, webinars, industry inputs, social accountability and ethical practices at every level are part of the curriculum instilling patriotism among students.

**Department of Mathematics:**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024

- Programming Languages with C++ (DSE)
- Programmers in Python (SEC)
- Basics in Late X (SEC)
- Elementary Statistics – I (SEC)
- Elementary Statistics – II (SEC)
- Mathematics for competitive examinations – I (SEC)
- Mathematics for competitive examinations – II (SEC)
- Number Theory (DSE)

**Department of Chemistry:**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024

- Practical papers (titrimetry, qualitative organic analysis, inorganic qualitative analysis, physical chemistry practical-I and Physical Chemistry practical-II) have been introduced in semester-1,2,3,5 and 6 respectively.
- Seven Skill enhancement courses have been introduced to facilitate the employability.
- Foundation course -Fundamentals of Chemistry has been introduced to bridge the gap between the higher secondary education and degree course.
- Professional competency skill course-Chemistry for competitive examinations has been introduced to enhance their strategic thinking and smart work.
- Summer internship/ industrial visit has been introduced to provide students an insight into the real working environment and interact with highly trained and experienced personnel.
- Four Discipline specific electives related to chemistry have been introduced with internal options.

**Department of Biochemistry:**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024

- Tissue Culture
- Research Methodology
- Basics of Forensic Science

**Department of Botany:**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024



- The syllabus revision was followed as per the recommendations of TANSCHÉ.
- Core course was changed to 15 instead of 16 as per the previous syllabus. Practical courses would be evaluated in the even semesters (yearend practical exam).
- Allied Botany would be referred to as Elective generic specific course. One of the elective paper is Practical Botany.
- Part IV includes skill enhancement courses for all 6 semesters.
- Skill enhancement course II will be a foundation course in the core subjects.
- SEC may be replaced with Naan Mudhalvan Scheme as when needed.
- EVS and value education has been shifted to II and III year respectively.
- The suggestions and recommendations put forth by the Board members were incorporated in the syllabus and the same syllabus was passed by the Board members on 27. 09.2023.

### **Department of Zoology:**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024

- Generic Elective I and II are introduced in the first and second semester respectively.
- Skill Enhancement courses have been introduced for UG degree courses. Basics of Computer I is introduced in Semester I and Basics of Computer II and Basic of Marine biology is introduced in Semester II.
- Skill Enhancement courses – Ornamental fish farming & management and Basics of Marine biology is introduced in Semester III.
- Skill Enhancement courses – Bio composting for Entrepreneurship and Wildlife conservation & management it introduced in Semester IV.
- A Foundation Course – Preparatory Course in Zoology in introduced in semester I to enable students to bridge the gap from school to college.
- Apart from the core courses, discipline specific electives are introduced in semester V and VI.
- Professional competency skill – Zoology for competitive examinations paper is introduced in the semester VI.

### **Department of Geography&GTTM:**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024

#### **B.Sc. Geography (2023-2024)**

Resolved to reframe the existing sequence of papers – Core, Elective, Skill Enhancement, Skill Foundation course according to TANSCHÉ –UG Syllabus.

In the core paper we have included Earth and it's System, Fundamentals of Geomorphology, Basis of GIS.

Specific Elective – 1) Research Writing Skills 2) Geo Spatial Technology or 3) Political Geography, 4) Recent Trends in Geography 5) GPS Technology 6) Social and Cultural Geography.

- Anatomy and Physiology course is included in the Third Semester as Discipline Specific Elective Paper – 3.
- Care and Prevention of Sports Injuries is included in the Fourth Semester as Discipline Specific Elective Paper-4.
- Practical-VI Handball (OR) Curriculum Design in Physical Education and Practical-VII Hockey (OR) Physiotherapy courses are introduced as optional courses for as Discipline Specific Elective Paper 5 & 6 in Fifth semester.
- Practical - IX Football (OR) Biomechanics and Practical - X Basketball and Badminton (OR) Kinesiology courses of DSE – 7 & 8 are introduced as optional papers in Sixth semester.
- Health Education course is included as Skill Enhancement Course - 1 and Safety Education and First Aid as Foundation Course in First Semester.
- Fitness and Nutrition course has been included as Skill Enhancement Course – 2 in Second semester.
- Cambridge English course has been introduced in the Second Semester. Basic Computer Application in Physical Education has been included as Skill Enhancement Course – 3 in Second semester.
- Naan Muthalvan / Elementary Statistics, Sports Management in Physical Education courses introduced as alternative courses for Naan Muthalvan Scheme SEC – 4 & 5.
- Naan Muthalvan / Sports Psychology, Naan Muthalvan / Research Methodology courses are introduced as alternative courses for Naan Muthalvan Scheme as SEC 6 & 7 in Fourth and Fifth semester respectively.
- Rules, Regulations, Officiating in Sports and Games – I & II (2 Papers) are merged into one paper i.e. Rules, Regulations, Officiating in Sports and Games – I(Athletics Field and Track Events) in Third semester.

- Professional Competency Skills course is included in Part IV under sixth semester.

### **Department of Computer Science:**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024

- In core, python programming Theory with practical and Data Analytics using R with Practical were introduced.
- In fifth semester, the internship and project were newly introduced.
- In DSE, Data Science, Robotics and its Applications were introduced.
- Artificial Intelligence Paper were included.
- SEC Papers were included, 2 in each semester.

### **Department of Computer Application**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024

The following New DSE Courses were Introduced

- Agile project management.
- Machine learning theory
- Machine learning lab.
- IOT and its applications
- Artificial Intelligence
- Natural language processing.
- Information Security

### **Department of Historical Studies:**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024

- The contents of all the Core Courses of the Syllabi have been formulated absolutely in accordance with the syllabus furnished by TANSCHÉ.
- The Elective Courses which has been opted in all the Semesters are absolutely discipline specific and will be handled by our Department itself.
- It has been resolved to opt the courses entitled Introduction to History and Introduction to Tourism from the B.A History syllabus of TANSCHÉ for SEC.
- The elective courses of TANSCHÉ viz., Indian Political Thought and Modern Governments has been incorporated as similar in the syllabus during the third and fourth semesters.
- The Skill Enhancement Courses of TANSCHÉ has been included in the syllabi with inter – changings between the semesters.



- The Indian Constitution course given the SEC category of TANSCHÉ has been changed into the Core course during the 5<sup>th</sup> Semester due to its importance.
- Two choices have been given for elective courses during the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Semesters. And, out of the two choices, all courses have been taken from TANSCHÉ except two formulated courses.
- The elective courses of TANSCHÉ such as Elements of Human Rights, History of Dravidian Movement, History of Revolutions during 5<sup>th</sup> Semester, International Relations and History of China & Japan during 6<sup>th</sup> Semester has been incorporated as such in the syllabus.
- The elective courses entitled – Women Record Makers of India during the 5<sup>th</sup> Semester, Tourism in Tamil Nadu and Women Change Makers of Tamil Nadu during the 6<sup>th</sup> Semester has been formulated.
- All the courses have been incorporated with the objective of helping the students to gain sufficient knowledge which would help them for higher studies and gain employment as soon as they complete the degree.

#### **Department of Sociology:**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024

- The syllabus have been revamped for B.A Sociology.
- The Department wanted to bring this change because we wanted to give new and improved form and structure to the syllabus.
- The new syllabus will enable the students to pursue higher education and to appear for any competitive exam with ease and also to enrich the students with research habits and to avail job opportunities through strong and ample learning of the core and related subjects.
- It would enable the students to identify their skills and use those skills to undertake research for the welfare of the society in terms of Planning and implementation of the minor and major research projects.

#### **Department of Economics:**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024

- The syllabus for the B.A. Economics Programme from the batch 2023-24, was framed as per TANSCHÉ guidelines. The Board of Studies Meetings of our Economics Dept were conducted in two spells to finalize the syllabus for the first two semesters on 5th July 2023 and for the rest of the semesters on 27th Sep 2023

- The revised syllabus includes 15 Core Courses, 4 Generic Elective Courses selected from 8 Elective Courses, 8 Discipline Specific Elective Courses (DSE) at the UG level as part III subjects.
- Moreover, Seven Skill Enhancement Courses and One Skill Enhancing Foundation Course were also introduced in the curriculum of UG, as part IV subjects

### **Key Changes Made In Core/Part-3 Courses From 2023-24:**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024

- Two international economics courses (as 1&2) offered earlier in 5th and 6th semesters are now merged as a single course and is offered in the 6th semester.
- Alternatively, only a single statistics for economics course was earlier offered in the second semester. Now, two courses as statistics for economics 1 & 2 are now offered in 1st and 2nd semesters
- A new industrial economics core course is now introduced in the 5th semester
- Basic econometrics was introduced to the students as a dse in the 6th semester.

### **Department of Music:**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024

- Syllabi of TANSCHS has been referred for updating of our syllabus.
- Uniformity has been maintained for all subjects in the Allotment of marks.
- Theory and practical hours Question paper pattern Internal evaluation pattern.

The Syllabus was aptly modified to equip each student imbibe the art to the best.

Elective, Foundation Course, Skill Enhancement Course have been added offering options focused to provide every good knowledge to students.

### **Department of English:**

The following were implemented in the Syllabus 2023 -2024

- Foundation course is prescribed in semester I for the students to learn the basics in literature
- New papers have been introduced to upskill students' ability in language and technology
- Value Education and EVS are included in semester IV

- Internship is included in semester V
- A common paper for all UG course is given under Professional Competency Skill in semester VI
- Extension Activity is included in semester VI

- In Industrial Law New Labour codes were added in unit V.
- Instead of Company law in IIIrd Semester, we have Introduced Company Law & Secretarial Practice-I and In IVth semester for GST & Customs Law, we have introduced Company Law & Secretarial Practice-II.
