CSIM pursues this mission by offering a wide range of training programs that advocates the principles and practices of social entrepreneurship. CSIM is a project of ManavaSeva Dharma Samvardhini Trust, a registered Public Charitable Trust established in 1999 by Mr PN. Devarajan. Its mission is to promote social consciousness amongst people, and nurture the passion of existing pioneers in the social work sector.

The Sociology department of Queen Mary's College has churned over thousands of Sociology graduates. In their bid to offer the current and latest courses that would aid in the skillset of the Sociology graduates, a course dealing with Social Enterprises and its Management will equip them on the current trends in the social sector and enable them to get job opportunities in the sector. With this in mind, the Sociology department is planning to partner with CSIM to offer the following -

- A. Under Graduate Diploma in Social Initiative & Management for the firstyear UG students of Sociology (15 months)
- B. Field Exposure visit for the final year UG students of Sociology
- C. NGO Internship for PG students of Sociology

- Attending both Theory& practical exams
- Getting a pass marks in all subjects

Effective Date, Amendment, Termination:

The MOU works for two full academic year. Based on the understanding and satisfaction of the training, it can be renewed every year.

If any weak performance or dissatisfaction between the two organizations, the MOU could be terminated only after completion of the running academic year.

Confidentiality:

All the resource materials provided by CSIM should not be shared by the Sociology Department with students not attending the course. The materials shall be kept in strict confidence with the department heads.

Non-binding

This Memorandum of Understanding is not intended to be a binding obligation by either party, nor shall it, or any actions taken in connection herewith, serve as a basis for reliance by either party. The MOU shall terminate

- i. by mutual written agreement of both parties;
- ii. unilaterally by either party by providing 90 days advance written notice; or
- iii. by either party upon a material breach by the other party of any of the provisions of Confidentiality, unless such breach has been waived, in writing, by the non-breaching party.
