### SCOPE OF THE MOU

### A. Exchange of Information

The two institutions will work to develop agreements or programs for exchanging academic, research and other educational materials.

### B. Exchange of Students

The parties will work to develop agreements and programs for students between the two institutions, either on the basis of reciprocal exchange of benefits or through fees set for the participation in the specific programs. Such programs shall be conducted so as to encourage active participation and to ensure reciprocity while minimizing the cost of participation for students.

## C. Collaborative Programs

Collaborative programs, seminars and research activities will be encouraged and supported where the mutual interests and expertise of both institutions may be furthered. Faculty and program directors at both institutions should be encouraged to enter into contract with one another in order to further this objective.

# D. Cooperation for Development of Resource.

The two institutions will explore avenues to develop financial resources to support educational activities sponsored under this Agreement, including joint consultancy and research grant proposals.

All the proposed initiatives will be governed by the regulations evolved by both the organizations under the "The University/ Company Partnership". These terms and conditions of the mutual assistance shall be discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties to the initiation of any particular programme.

### Terms of the MOU

- This MOU will be in force for a period of thirty-six (36) months from the date of signing. 1. This MOU may be terminated by either party by giving a prior written notice of 30 days to the other party.
- This MOU can be further extended, subject to mutual agreement of terms and conditions at 2. the end of thirty-six (36) months, on expiry of the MOU. The intimation ofdesire to continue should be intimated in writing two months prior to the date of expiry of this MOU.
- This MOU or any action of the parties with respect thereto does not constitute legally 3. binding obligations by both the parties. It only intends to lay out the spirit and understanding of the arrangement for mutual benefit of the respective parties.
- 4. This MOU does not create any partnership, agency, joint venture or employer —employee relationship between the parties.
- The parties shall be responsible for their respective costs, loss and expenses and no party 5. shall be responsible to the other for any loss, cost, expense or damages whether direct, indirect, consequential or incidental.

### Termination of Contract

 In the event the CLIENT is unable to ensure the operation of the work within the stipulated time period, it could be entitled to terminate this Memorandum of Understanding.
